




## **Construction Demand in 2019**

# **Average Price of Construction Materials in 2019**





#### **Built Environment Accelerate to Market Programme**

- a) An accelerator programme for companies with new solutions
- b) Up to 70% funding support
- c) Purpose is to accelerate their solutions in the market
- d) Brings together inventors, innovators, industry and firms to fast track the innovation process for new built environment solutions

### **Recent Government Measures**




#### **Green Buildings Innovation Cluster Programme (GBIC)**

- a) Top-up of USD14 million (SGD20 million) to the GBIC which started in 2014
- b) Encourage developers and building owners to introduce eco-friendly innovations, such as super low-energy (SLE) technologies
- c) Other initiatives to support eco-friendly innovations:
  - Super Low-Energy Buildings Smart Hub, a new digital knowledge portal for green buildings
  - The Hubble Platform, a digital platform that allows for sharing of data








**Mass Rapid Transit Circle Line 6**





## **Conclusion**
